9 This meeting of the Kansas Board of Veterinary Examiners was called to order at 7:01 A.M. by
10 Board President Dr. Dodson. Board Members in attendance in addition to Dr. Dodson were
11 Drs. Bentz, Bogue, Kobuszewski, Ritter, Snyder and Joseph Allen. Also participating in the
12 conference call were Drs. Hanson and Hedrick; Konrad Coe, Cheryl Mermis, General Counsel
13 Athena Andaya, Litigation Counsel Tom Nanney.

14 Dr. Dodson welcomed and thanked those in attendance.

17 Mr. Allen made a motion to adopt the agenda, Dr. Kobuszewski seconded the motion. The
18 motion passed on a voice vote with no dissenting votes.

20 There was no one present for the public forum.

22 The topic of discussion for today's meeting centered on listing disciplinary actions, taken by the
23 KBVE, on the agency website. The board members independently researched websites from
24 the Board of Healing Arts, KS Judicial Branch, and veterinary licensing entities in Georgia,
25 Minnesota, Virginia, and West Virginia. The consensus of the board members was that in
26 order to protect the public and be more transparent, final orders should be made available
27 through the agency's website.

29 Mr. Allen made the motion to establish the practice -to post corrective actions and license
30 disciplines on the agency website, further recommending that the website of the Minnesota
31 Board of Veterinary Medicine be used as an example. Dr. Bogue seconded the motion. The
32 motion passed on a voice vote with no dissenting votes.

34 The agency staff will work with legal counsel on establishing the protocols for publication of
35 KBVE disciplinary actions, on the agency website.

37 Next meetings of the board will be Tuesday, January 30 and Wednesday, January 31, 2018, in
38 Topeka; Wednesday, April 4, 2018, in Wamego.

40 Dr. Bogue made a motion to adjourn the meeting with Dr. Kobuszewski seconding the
41 motion. The motion passed on a voice vote with no dissenting votes.
