BOARD MEETING - QUORUM

This Meeting of the Kansas Board of Veterinary Examiners was called to order at 12:04 PM by Board President Dr. Dodson. Board Members in attendance in addition to Dr. Dodson were Drs. Flowers, Snyder, Bentz, Ritter and Mr. Allen. Also present were staff members Dr. Johnson, Konrad Coe, and Matthew Provencher. Charles Macheers, General Counsel was in attendance and Litigation Counsel, Jan Weiler. Dr. Bentz and Dr. Ritter were absent. There were no public members in attendance.

Dr. Dodson welcomed and thanked those in attendance. A quorum of board members was present.

Executive order 20-39 filed on May 26th appears to be inconsistent in the date of when the KBVE needs to send out certified letters to veterinarians who have not renewed. Several boards determined the disaster extension deadline is until June 30th.

Some of the Boards have put a statement on their website concerning the Executive Order and deadlines for renewals of licenses.

We have made a courtesy phone call to those veterinarians and technicians who have not renewed.

Mr. Allen moved our legal counsel to provide a statement to be published on the KBVE website as soon as possible concerning the impact of Executive Order 20-39 on license and premise renewals. This was due to the rescinding of Executive Order 20-19 by the publication of Executive Order 20-39 on May 26th. Dr. Flowers seconded the motion, motion passed with no dissenting votes.

Mr. Allen moved the meeting to be adjourned and Dr. Snyder seconded the motion. The meeting adjourned at 12:40pm
