5. Any renewal fees, deadlines, or other requirements shall remain extended pursuant to paragraphs 1 or 2 of Executive Order 12-09 (and its predecessor orders) shall remain extended until at least 15 days after the relevant licensing authority provides notice to licensees through publication on the agency's website or through other electronic means regularly used by the agency to communicate with the agency's licensees.

6. Any license not current as of the earlier of an agency-selected date published pursuant to paragraph 5 above or the expiration of this order shall be subject to the licensing agency's normal authority to impose late fees and such license shall not continue to be effective by virtue of this or any previous executive order.

Therefore, any veterinary license or veterinary technician registration that was not renewed in 2020 will be terminated on May 20th, 2021.

Late fees for veterinary licenses and veterinary premises will be in effect if not paid or postmarked by June 30, 2021.
