7 This special meeting of the Kansas Board of Veterinary Examiners (KBVE) was called to
8 order at 7:03 A.M. by Board President Dodson. The meeting was held by conference
9 call. Board Members participating on the call and responding by voice
10 acknowledgement were Mr. Allen, Drs. Covington, Dodson, Flowers, and Snyder. Also
11 present in person were Mr. Randy Forbes, Konrad Coe, Matthew Provencher, Audi
12 Westgate, and Dr. Jody Johnson.

13 Dr. Snyder moved that the agenda be approved. It was seconded by Dr. Flowers.
14 Motion passed on a roll call voice vote with no dissenting votes.

15 Dr. Johnson reviewed the proposal of the "Continuity of Service" for legal counsel by
16 Frieden and Forbes, LLP. Mr. Allen moved and Dr. Snyder seconded that Dr. Johnson
17 go forward with the proposal. Motion passed on a roll call voice vote with no dissenting
18 votes.

19 Dr. Johnson reviewed the situation with the KSU-CVM Veterinary Teaching Hospital and
20 the renewal of an institutional license for an intern requesting to stay until mid July. The
21 statutes indicate an institutional license for an intern ends on June 30. The institutional
22 license can be renewed for a \$25 fee. No action is required.

23 Dr. Johnson brought forth a request that a veterinary technician's Kansas registration be
24 reinstated after 40 years. There is no proof that the VTNE was ever taken. She will be
25 required by statute to prove she has passed the VTNE.

26 Dr. Johnson reminded the Board members of the next meeting on July 14th in Wamego
27 and November 10. Both scheduled to begin at 10 A.M.

28 The Probable Cause Committee will wait 2 minutes after adjournment and call back in on
29 the conference call line.

30 Dr. Flowers made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:27 A.M. Motion seconded by Dr.
31 Snyder.
